Shortlisting Criteria for Full Time MBA(IB) and MBA(BA) 2025-27 Programmes

The admission to IIFT's Full Time MBA (IB) and MBA(BA) 2025-27 programmes is on the basis of CAT 2024 Score, Group Discussion (GD), Personal Interview (PI) and other parameters i.e. Gender Diversity, Academic Diversity and Work Experience. The process will be carried out in two stages as follows:

Stage 1: (Short listing):

The short listing of candidates for Group Discussion and Personal Interview will be done on the basis of CAT 2024 Score including sectional cut offs and Gender Diversity.

Stage 2: (Group Discussion and Personal Interview): The shortlisted candidates will go through the following process :-

Final IIFT score carry the maximum weightage and additional criteria of Academic diversity, Gender diversity, Work experience for final selection. In addition to this, the candidate has to appear for Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

Table 2 presents the criteria for final selection of candidates to the MBA-IB and MBA(BA) 2025-27 programmes.

** Final Score of Work Experience = Score based on number of year of experience X Score given by faculty in interview panel on 10 point Likert scale / 10
